## Animal Experience

*1984-1996* Volunteered during summer breaks at Steve Martin's Working Wildlife, (my uncle's) ranch. Duties involved: the care and preparations of diets, cleaning and feeding for various animals. Took various young and older animals on walks, or into exercise area. Assisted when animals became ill, and when they needed daily attention and care such as feeding administrating need of medication sometimes on an hourly basis. Became extremely interested in assisting in the educational programs, assisted in live exhibitions with animals at schools, and tours at the facility. Assisted when possible in film, and commercial projects gaining training knowledge.

### Took special interest in these animals:

Alligators, snakes, turtles, scorpions, tarantulas, ravens, macaws, owls, ferrets, squirrels, raccoons, chinchillas, binturong, coatimundi, lemur, kinkajou, and various smaller wild cats such as; ( caracals, bobcats, servals). As my experience expanded I then began helping in the care, maintained, and training of larger animals such as; bears, lions, tigers, leopards, cougars and even **chimpanzees & monkeys**. Leaned about how to mix certain species together for their social enhancement and just to have plain fun playing together.
